## Bates County Fair Queen Rules

1. Candidates must be a member of a Bates County club, organization or church.
2. Candidates must be single, never married and childless.
3. Candidates must be 16-22 years of age by July 10, 2011.
4. Candidates must pre-register at the Butler Area Chamber of Commerce office, 7 W. Dakota, Butler, MO by May 27, 2011.
5. All candidates will receive informational packets at the pre-dinner date, June 1, 2011. Dinner is for candidates and parents. Time and location TBA.
6. Queen candidates shall be judged as follows:

Interview (poise, personality, attributes)	50 points
Fair and fair knowledge	50 points
Ticket sales, raffle tickets, fair share sales	50 points

Determined by 5 points for first \$1000 in sales; then 1 point per \$100 of sales to a maximum of 50 points total.  
Interview to be held on: time & date TBA
7. Candidates are expected to ride in the Fair parade, the area Fourth of July parades and make as many personal appearances as possible during sale time to sell tickets, promote herself and the fair.
8. Candidates shall receive:

10% of the first \$2500 in ticket sales
15% from \$2501 to \$3999 in sales
20% above \$4000. NO MAXIMUM ON SALES
9. All event tickets shall be turned in each day during the fair by 5 p.m. at the Youth Building fair office. NO ticket sales after 5 p.m. on the day of the event.
10. All money shall be turned in Saturday, June 18, 2011, by NOON.
11. All candidates are eligible for the special top sales award of \$100.
12. The Queen shall receive in addition to her sales percentage:

\$100 savings bond
\$100 gift certificate
College scholarship: \$125 per semester (\$250 per year) up to \$1000 total. Money to be given at the completion of each college or technical school semester with presentation of grade sheet. Must maintain a minimum 2.0 GPA. Scholarship must be forfeited if semesters do not run consecutively.
13. The next two (2) runners up shall receive:

\$50 savings bond
\$50 gift certificate
14. Coronation will be held Saturday evening at the Bull Extravaganza.
15. Money will be awarded to Queen and Princess after pictures are taken by Bartz Photography, date TBA.
